Conditions of Loans

Applicants must have completed at least four course credits and have maintained a minimum GPA of 2.75. The maximum amount an undergraduate student can borrow from the fund is **\$3,000**. Recipients must be full-time students when the approved amount of the loan is paid to Framingham State University. These payments are made in full after Add/Drop Day in the fall or spring following approval. The maximum amount a graduate student can borrow is **\$2000**.

Educational loans are made without interest. Repayment of the entire amount of the principal will be made on either completion or termination of undergraduate studies at Framingham State University, on a payment schedule of \$50.00 a month (a minimum rate of \$600.00 per year).
